STOP For School Bus Red Lights

California law requires you to stop at least 20 feet before reaching the school bus, and remain stopped as long as the red lights on the school bus are flashing. If you fail to stop, you may be fined up to \$1,000 and your driving privilege could be suspended for 1 year. There are many school buses traveling throughout the City of Ione, and it is important to be mindful of the safety of school children. Just because a school bus is pulled to the side of the road, does not mean you can pass. If the red light is flashing---**STOP YOUR CAR!**
